Community Health Representatives (CHRs) work to improve health in the communities they serve by providing basic health care, health promotion, and disease and injury prevention services.

CHRs provide in home visits for Native American families and participate in community and group events.

Duties that CAN be Performed by CHRs Include:

- Provide Health Education
- Monitor Health, Including checking Vital Signs and Blood Glucose
- Assist with Tracking and Scheduling Appointments and Transportation
- Monitor Home Safety
- Assist with Scheduling Appointments
- Perform Medication Reviews
- Deliver Medications during Visits

Duties that CHRs CANNOT Perform Include:

- Provide In-Home Nursing Services
- Diagnose or Treat Medical Conditions
- Dispense Prescribed or Over-the-Counter Medications
- Take Patients Shopping
- Cook
- Clean Homes
- Wash Dishes
- Routinely Transport Patients
